Reminders

Our Pre-Kindergarten students will go outside daily, weather permitting. Please dress your child appropriately for the colder weather. Children should be able to put on their coats independently. Practice at home with this, including fastening buttons, snaps, zippers and putting on boots/gloves, is very helpful.
